



Ice Cream Making Club

Sessions Overview



Course goals:

- Learn the science behind ice cream making
- Explore different flavours and ingredients
- Develop teamwork and creativity
- Understand the cultural significance of ice cream around the world

Week 1: Introduction to Ice Cream

Objective: Learn what ice cream is, its history, and how it's made.

- Fun icebreaker: Favourite ice cream flavours
- Short presentation on the history of ice cream
- Experiment: What happens when we freeze milk? (Basic science of freezing)
- Activity: Create ice cream flavour brainstorm board

Week 2: Science of Ice Cream – Making Ice Cream in a Bag!

Objective: Understand the role of ingredients in ice cream making.

- Learn about emulsions and freezing points
- Hands-on activity: Make ice cream using ziplock bags (milk, sugar, vanilla, ice, and salt)
- Taste test & discuss how salt affects ice

Week 3: Flavour Experiments & Mix-ins

Objective: Explore different flavour combinations and mix-ins.

- Learn about natural and artificial flavours

- Activity: Create mini “flavour lab” stations with ingredients like cocoa, fruit purees, cinnamon, and honey
- Make a basic ice cream base and divide into groups to add different mix-ins
- Voting on the best flavours!

Week 4: Ice Cream Around the World

Objective: Discover how different cultures enjoy frozen treats.

- Presentation on global frozen desserts (e.g., Italian gelato, Thai rolled ice cream, Indian kulfi, Japanese mochi)
- Tasting activity: Try small samples of different frozen treats (if available)
- Group challenge: Design an international ice cream flavour

Week 5: Ice Cream Business & Marketing

Objective: Learn how ice cream is sold and marketed.

- Discuss branding, packaging, and logos
- Activity: Design and decorate a logo and ice cream tub for their own flavour
- Group challenge: Create a fun name and slogan for their ice cream

Week 6: Ice Cream Party & Certificates

Objective: Celebrate learning with a final ice cream-making competition!

- Teams create their own unique ice cream flavours from scratch
- Ice cream tasting and friendly judging
- Hand out “Junior Ice Cream Maker” certificates
- Fun reflection: What did we learn?
