There is of course the more serious side to attendance. Our attendance target is set to ensure that pupils are receiving the education they deserve and significant gaps in attendance are a real barrier to that. One of our most significant barriers to attendance is that caused by term-time holidays. As we know, school must report any family holidays of 5 days or more for issue of a PN2 notice. Where an unauthorised holiday is taken adjoining reported illness, the period of illness is likely to be recorded as 'Reason to Believe' that the absence may not be illness related but part of the holiday. In such cases, supporting evidence will be required (such as flight details) for submitting to Barnsley Authority, in line with our attendance procedures.

A Warm Welcome

Our Year 1 and 2 children attended the Places of Worship visit to Wakefield Cathedral, followed by Jamia Masjid Safia mosque. The visit was a lovely experience and both places of worship went out of their way to welcome our school, share their special place of worship and provide fun activities for the children. In the Cathedral, the children found out about special journeys and completed different tasks that told the story of the nativity (such as finding knitted sheep hidden around the main hall!) In the mosque, we were treated to a call to prayer by the Imam and the children were mesmerised by the sound of this...you could hear a pin drop in the hall following the call. It was especially entertaining for the adults accompanying the trip as the Iman was dressed in hi-viz work gear, steel toe boots and a hard hat as he was helping with construction of the new mosque next door! We were proud of the children's behaviour and respect for these special places and were blown away by the welcoming way in which our pupil's questions were dealt with!
